1 MBA Studies + CPT

- Curricular Practical Training (CPT) stands for Curricular Practical Training, it is integral to your major and the experience must be part of your program of study.
- CPT is an on- or off-site employment option for F-1 students.
- Students are allowed to work for the full duration of their studies either full-time or part-time. To be eligible to participate in the OPT after graduation, students full-time CPT must be 12 months or less.
- Hospitality Academy collaborates with Placement International to offer the best opportunities to our students.




- Optional Professional Training (OPT) is temporary employment that is directly related to the major.
- OPT upon successful graduation, allowing students to extend their stay in the USA for 1 year while they work.
- Hospitality Academy collaborates with Placement International to offer the best opportunities to our graduates too.

At **Hospitality Academy**, our students normally take a post-completion OPT, allowing them to extend their stay in the USA for an entire year upon graduation. After the OPT is completed, if the host company is willing to sponsor, students are able to apply for an H1Bwork visa.



PAYMENT TERMS

- The Registration Fee is non-refundable and payable online at the time of application. A new Registration Fee will apply if a candidate has not complied with the requirements to be submitted for acceptance into the study program within 365 days from the date of registration fee payment
- Every transaction will incur a fee on both ends (through the payer and payee). This amount will be added in the invoice to ensure the complete amount is received.
- · Hospitality Academy offers payment plans, students have the opportunity to pay their tuition fees in instalments.
- Upon acceptance, the student will be provided with the student manual. This document specifies the Rules and Regulations, Terms and Conditions, as well as Cancellation Terms and Refund Policies..

Additional fees you could expect to pay afterwards:

- SEVIS Fee: Student Exchange Visitor Information System SEVIS is administered by the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) within the Department of Homeland Security (DHS). It is a computer database that maintains information on foreign students and exchange visitors before and during their stay in the United States. The amount of this fee is \$350.00 (might be subject to change).
- \cdot US Embassy Appointment/Interview Fee: \sim \$ 185.00 (please check official US Embassy website for further information regarding the exact amount in your location).
- Airfare This expense will vary depending on geographical location.
- Relocation Fees (i.e. transportation, food and beverage, rent for housing, security deposit, and additional expenses when arriving to the United States) This will vary depending on the area or features. However, we recommend bringing the following amount: \$ 1,500.00 to \$ 2,000.00.
- · Medical insurance coverage
- USCIS OPT application fee. The amount of this fee is \$410.00 (might be subject to change).
- A \$250.00 USD administrative fee will apply for the application of a F2 Visa

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Tuition and fees may be paid by credit card, debit card or wire transfer.

Prior to the last day of the Registration Period, the student should have either;

- · Settled the total amount;
- Settled the due amount specified in their Payment Plan.

Payment Plan Options:

The Registration Fee of \$550.00 is non-refundable and payable online at the time of application.

- **1.**Full payment of Yearly Fees before traveling; \$33,200.00 to be paid upon acceptance and prior to the commencement of the Visa Application Process. Total fee: \$33,750.00 (incl. reg fee)
- 2. Payment by Academic Semester; \$5,625.00 to be paid upon acceptance and prior to the commencement of the Visa Application Process + 5 installments of \$5,515.00 payable 4 weeks prior to the beginning of the semester. The first installment after the program commencement is due by the 4th week of the commencement date of the program. Total fee: \$33,750.00 (incl. reg fee)
- **3.** Monthly Payments; \$5,625.00 to be paid upon acceptance and prior to the commencement of the Visa Application Process + 20 installments of \$1,378.75 payable by month and starting from the 1st day of the study program. Total fee: \$33,750.00 (incl. reg fee)

All late payments will have a penalty of \$25.00 late fee charge to the account.

Accepted students will be informed prior to each semester in case of any variation in the program prices.
